Nature & Scope of Work

An employee of this class is deemed to be a non-permanent seasonal employee.

This is unskilled manual work involving the performance of routine labouring tasks in a wide variety of construction, maintenance, and repair operations, including both heavy and light physical labour.

Examples of Work

- ◆ A variety of pick and shovel work - digging, filling, etc.
- ◆ Assisting semi-skilled Labour on all jobs required.
- ◆ Loading and unloading various materials.
- ◆ Manual tasks in maintenance, repairing, and construction of streets, sidewalks, storm sewers, sewer and water projects, etc.

Desired Knowledge, Abilities & Skill

- ◆ Ability to effectively carry out oral and written instructions with a minimum of supervision.
- ◆ Ability to perform assigned tasks.
- ◆ Some experience in performing labour tasks is preferable.
- ◆ A Class 5 or better Manitoba Driver's Licence is required.
- ◆ Grade 12 education or G.E.D.
